



Robert Henry Collyns

Born in 1895 at The Green Dulverton to Robert, a medical practitioner, and Eleanor, he had brothers Gilbert and Percival. The whole family moving across to Bilboa House in due course.

Robert joined the Royal Engineers on leaving school rising to the rank of Major when he went to France October 1915, he was twice mentioned in despatches and received the Military Cross and the Chevalier de L'Ordre National de la Legion d'honneur before dying of wounds at Epernay on 1st June 1918.

His gravestone is at the Terlincthun British Cemetery Wimille, whilst there is a memorial plaque on the Dulverton Church wall.

Joan Ferguson (nee Page), who many of you will remember, told me some time ago that her father, Bert, the billiards champion, who was a Corporal in the Royal Engineers, met up with Robert shortly before he died.






