





#### **Wool Grading on Exmoor**

#### By Brian Boundy, Senior Head Grader in the South Molton branch of the British Wool Marketing Board.

#### **Wool Grading**

Wool is graded for its quality, lower quality for insulation, medium quality for carpets and higher for garments, thread and yarn. Exmoor sheep are mainly cross breeds, mules, some exmoor horn, a handful of closewool farmers.

Local producers of the wool book in their wool to the depot, can see it being graded and talk to the grader about the clip and ask if there are any problems and how they can extract the maximum value for their clip.



Once the wool is graded a sample from each bale is take. This is tested for micron count which is the fineness of the fibre, colour quality any contamination and yield. The grading system is vital to ensure a market for all types of wool. Last year the average price per kilo of UK wool was 85p.

It is then scoured (washed) a process in which it loses about 30pc of its weight.

All sorts of things have been found in the wool including spectacles and an iron cooking pot, knives



Brian grading at the depot (unfortunately), electric extension cables, and tools. There have even been needles and test tubes used for blood testing found in the wool.

#### **Local Shows**

Mike Berry, Depot Manager and Brian Boundy both judge fleeces and wool on the hoof at local shows. The wool is marked on quality, colour, presentation, staple strength (the staple is the wool fibre itself) and if the wool is a good representation of its breed. There is a golden fleece competition and all producers are eligible to enter via the depot or at certain shows.

#### The British Wool Marketing Board

The British Wool Marketing Board (BWMB) represent 45,000 farmers in the U.K. It promotes British wool through the campaign for wool whose patron is HRH Prince Charles. BWMB have 11 depots in the UK, 2 of which are in the Westcountry; South Molton and Liskeard. Last year it sold a total of £35m through auctions. The auctions are held with a click of a mouse on systems similar to flower auctions in Holland. One third of the clip is exported to China and 48pc to mainland Europe, mainly for carpeting. The South Molton depot was created in 1973 because North Molton at the time was the most densely populated area in the country for sheep. There are 3 qualified graders in South Molton and 3 apprentices. The depot handles approx. 2.5m kilos of wool per year.

Grading ensures high quality for British wool that buyers can trust. Without the marketing board many farmers would struggle to sell their fleeces. The average number of sheep per farm in the UK (and the Westcountry) is 350. Some farmers only have 10 or 15 sheep and the larger Westcountry producers have 7-8,000 sheep.

It is interesting to note that GB is home to more breeds of sheep than anywhere in the world with more than 60 varieties, New Zealand (which produces four times the volume of wool than the UK) has four.

The boxes provide shelter and safe nest sites for summer breeding. Most mice have regular broods, but dormice (not actually a mouse, despite the name) live much longer, around 5 years, have smaller broods and usually only one a year. A pair of dormice will usually have a brood of 4 – 6 of which maybe only one or two will survive their first year to breed themselves, making the population very vulnerable.

Patrick Watts-Mabbott, volunteer and outreach officer at Exmoor National Park says: "The boxes also make monitoring the health and population of the dormice much easier, so if you would like to help us please donate what you can and give a dormouse a home this winter."





# Venus and Mars put on a show for the new year

During most of January and February, Mars and Venus will be close together in the sky, a phenomenon known as a conjunction. If you look towards the South-West, low in the sky just after sunset you'll see them as two bright stars. The brightest one is Venus and will appear bluish white. The one with a reddish hue is of course Mars. On the evenings of January 31 and February 1 the crescent moon will be right next to them creating quite a spectacular show!

Conjunctions such as this are actually fairly common and it's all to do with how the Solar System formed. Astronomers believe that the planets formed out of a big disc of dust and gas that surrounded the young sun. Because the disc was flattened out by its spinning motion, all the new planets that formed orbit on a more or less flat plane. Rather like athletes running around a track each in their own lane and just like athletes, some run faster than others.

If you imagine standing on the sports field watching the race, sometimes two or three runners will appear together and at other times they'll be spread out in different directions. The planets are just the same, the ones closer to the sun such as Venus "run" faster than the ones further out like Mars. From where we're standing on the Earth, we'll see Venus catch up and overtake Mars on the inside lane.

Regardless of the science behind it, two bright planets and the moon should look amazing in the sky above Exmoor's beautiful landscape. Perhaps a great opportunity for a photo!
