WORLD WAR 1 CENTENARY COMMEMORATIONS

Many of you will have read the small booklet that I wrote for the unveiling of the War Memorial in 2006, either at that event or at the Heritage Centre's centenary commemorations. However, more information becomes available all the time especially the publishing of the 2011 Census so I thought it would be good to commemorate the centenaries of each of the men who lost their lives

This month it's William John Newbury.

William was born 1894 at Bridge Street Dulverton to John and Elizabeth with a brother Henry and sisters, Ann, Mary, Maud and Lily. Subsequently the family moved to Rosemary Lane and by 1911 William was working as a gardener.

William joined the Devonshire Regiment going to India in early 1914 stationed near Lahore and then he was sent to Mespotania in April 1914. He became a Lance Corporal but died of his wounds on 24th January 1916 and is buried at the Kut War Cemetery. Several of you will remember his sister, Lily Webber, whilst his niece is still living in the area

Roger Watts plays opposite


her as the bumbling King Bertram. Julian Soltau is intellectually-challenged as Simple Simon, the cowman.

GONE FISHING

For many vears Trout and

Salmon fishing on Exmoor was a rather private affair, most of the river was owned by private individuals or families and unless vou received an invite a days fishing was rather difficult. Fortunately the situation has changed over the last 10 years or so and access to some good water is straight forward. The Dulverton Angling Association has approx. 7 miles of bank on the Exe and Barle which is good Brown Trout water with a few Grayling and occasional Salmon while the 'Fish The Exe' project lets out Salmon days on some very good water on the Exe from Exebridge down to Bickleigh. All of these waters are available at a minimum cost, DAA membership is only £35.00 per adult and £1.00 for children.

These waters are available because the owners recognise that they have a broader responsibility to the general public, public funds pay for some river maintenance, though this is getting smaller and smaller as the years go by, therefore the public should be able to access the rivers, in a responsible, controlled, manner. All fishing in Exmoor's rivers depend on sufficient rainfall during the summer to keep them clean, fresh and well oxygenated, we must be the only group that wants lots of rain during the summer, as we have just had, however its not necessary for it to keep raining after the season has closed, day after day after day. Here on Exmoor we live in a Dark Sky area and when we get a clear night there are wonders to view when we look up at the stars. Here are a few sights to gaze at. During March and April the planet Jupiter is the brightest object (other than the Moon) in the night sky visible all night long in the Southeast at about 10pm. Mars rises in the SE but Venus, which in January was the morning star, has now disappeared into the glare of dawn. Of

the constellations Orion, the hunter, is to be seen low in the SW but the Plough, higher in the sky is always in view and has the pointers to the Pole Star. The 20th March is the Vernal Equinox (equal day and night) and marks the end of Winter and the beginning of Spring.


Don't forget that the clocks go forward one hour on the 27th March. There are Full Moons on 23rd March and 22nd April. Des Belam


Wimbleball Lake March16

2015 has been a fantastic year for Wimbleball – we were awarded our 4th consecutive Green Tourism Business Scheme at level Gold in December, hosted Wimbleball Rowing Club Regatta in June, and the South Coast Rowing Championship Regatta in September, which saw 1500 rowers from as far afield as Shoreham compete for prizes. Conservation work centred around siting and experimenting with our new charcoal kiln. Another new development for 2016 - The Wimbleball café has just been taken on by Ellie Street and Michele Romaine, who are renaming it 'The Duck' – expect lots of delicious homemade food and drinks.

We are very much looking forward to the 2016 season, which also sees 2 new triathlon events being hosted at Wimbleball – time to get into training anyone?
