Shaping Stories



Exmoor has long attracted and inspired writers and poets, from Wordsworth, Coleridge and Shelley, to Marie Corelli and Henry Williamson and, of course, R D Blackmore and Hope Bourne. Today's Exmoor writers include Devon-born novelist, Kate Lord Brown, who now calls Dulverton home.

After living in different parts of the world, most recently the Middle East, Kate and her family - husband, two children, and adopted dogs and cats - returned to England four years ago. 'I had happy childhood memories of Stoodleigh,' says Kate, 'and Dulverton appealed to us as it has so much to offer.' It is also within easy reach of the North Devon coast where the family loves to swim and surf, just as Kate did as a girl.

After reading philosophy at Durham and art history at the Courtauld Institute, Kate worked as an art curator, but writing has always been part of her life. 'I won my first writing prize while I was at school and, much later, completed an MA in creative writing.'

Her breakthrough came in 2009, as a finalist in ITV's *The People's Author* contest; her first novel, *The Beauty Chorus* came out two years later. In 2014, Kate's second novel, *The Perfume Garden*, was shortlisted for Romantic Novel of the Year; four more followed, the latest, *Silent Music*, in 2019.

Starting points tend to be what Kate calls, 'Little nuggets of history'. *The Beauty Chorus*, for example, was inspired by the obituary of a woman who had been a WWII Spitfire pilot. The novel she is currently working on features wartime Tiverton, where J D Salinger, author of *The Catcher in the Rye*, was stationed for three months.

And now you could have a character in that next novel named after you, as Kate is currently taking part in Children in Read, which is raising money for this year's Children in Need appeal. But hurry, bids close on 12 November! (See Children in Read at www.jumblebee.co.uk)

She keeps to a strict routine, writing between the twice-daily school runs and walking her dogs. I write in the mornings and afternoons; evenings are for research or going through what I have written earlier. Kate is an avid reader too; she particularly enjoys the novels of Ann Patchett, Elizabeth Strout and Anne Tyler but her favourite book is *The Leopard* by Giuseppe di Lampedusa. I discover something new each time I read it.

WHATS HOT IN THE EXMOOR PROPERTY MARKET?

Like most parts of the UK, the property market has been exceptionally busy since agents were allowed back to work on May 13th. Locally it's been no exception. If anything the volume of enquiries coming in compared with a more normal Exmoor property market has been and indeed continues to be, staggering. (between June and the end of September almost a whole year's worth of viewings carried out in 4 months alone).

Viewings levels are great but has this translated into sales and if so what has seen the greatest activity? In truth, almost every property type that you can think of and almost at every price range has been in demand. So many properties selling close to, at or indeed above their guide prices in recent weeks as multiple buvers have battled it out to secure their perfect home. The most extreme sector of the property market though having been particularly properties with land (5/10/20/30 acres) where the vast majority of landed properties have seen 10/20 or more viewings in the first few weeks, followed by multiple offers (sometimes 3/5 or even 8 different buvers) all chasing the same property. As a result, a very high percentage of these properties have sold at or above their Guide Price (some by 5/10% or even extreme cases of 14%).

But what of the market ahead? For now,

the market continues unabated despite COVID, despite BREXIT negotiations and despite the undoubted issues in the economy at large. 

NEWS FROM YOUR VILLAGE AGENT

Autumn is here and the winter flu vaccination programme is in full swing — it's especially important this year to get your flu vaccine if you are eligible for the free treatment, and maybe consider paying for one if you aren't. This year the flu vaccine is being offered on the NHS to:

- adults 65 and over
- * people with certain medical conditions (including children in at-risk groups from 6 months of age)
- * pregnant women
- * people living with someone who's at high risk from coronavirus (on the NHS shielded patient list)
- * children aged 2 and 3 on 31 August 2020, children in primary school & year 7 pupils
- * frontline health or social care workers.

You can have your NHS flu vaccine at:

- your GP surgery or local Hospital
- * a local pharmacy offering the service
- * your midwifery service if they offer it for pregnant women.

All this year's Exmoor Medical Centre flu vaccination clinics will take place at Exmoor Medical Centre in Dulverton. All clinics are appointment based only — please do not just turn up. Appointments are available to book through Patient Access or the Reception Team on 01398 323333. Flu vaccinations for those aged 50 — 64 will not be started until November unless you are in at an risk group when you will receive an invite to the Saturday, 17th October clinic.

Somerset CCG are also looking at one-stop shop type locations where people can get Covid testing, flu vaccinations, Covid vaccinations & anti-body testing. If you have your flu vaccine at a pharmacy, you do not have to inform a GP. It's up to the pharmacist to do that.

support has not wavered. The work of clinical teams remains ongoing; staff are visiting patients in your community, supporting families and caring 24/7 in the in-patient unit. The 24-hour adviceline has increasingly become a 'lifeline' to patients and families as face to face contact has not been possible.

Kara Fundraising Frampton, Area Manager at St Margaret's Hospice Care, said: "So many of you support the hospice by donating your change whilst out and about, it is such an important part of our fundraising efforts. Perhaps you could donate the cost of a cup of coffee, or could you donate some of the money you've saved on lunch while working from home. As it's our 40th year, we are hoping to raise £4,000, which will start to bridge the gap from not being able to hold bucket collections. Whether it's £2 or £20 your donation will help us continue to care for and support patients and their families across Somerset."

Recycling sterling silver can be easier than you think

Ever wondered what to do with broken jewellery, odd earrings, an old silver fork or spoon? Melting it down to make unique hand made pieces is easier than you may think.

At a time when reuse and recycle is on so many peoples minds, but access to the skills needed are not always easy to find, I am enjoying sharing my jewellery workshop with curious visitors or eager course participants.

There is something magical about taking silver from a solid, to a liquid, to something new and beautiful, be that casting and forging into simple rings and

bangles or using the ancient technique of cuttlebone casting.

Cuttlebone casting dates back hundreds of years and creates totally one off pieces that capture hand carved designs, whilst rettaining the beautiful organic "waves" that are the natural structure of the cuttlebone.

You can often find cuttlebones washed up on beaches, a by-product of the sea, so nothing is harmed when used in this way.

I love the process of taking scrap, melting it down, mixing old with new and tapping into waste as a resource.

Surely recycle and reuse is the way forward, in a world already full of stuff.







'Lets Get West Somerset Moving Again' Car Appeal

vehicles over. Any vehicles that are beyond repair will be sold for parts, with all the profits put back into the project.

Katherine Armstrong, CCS Community Involvement Officer, says:

"Please donate your unneeded cars to provide transport for lower-income people to get back into work and education.

First, we will service the vehicle and undertake any minor repairs to gain a 12-month MOT. At the time of being given the vehicle, the recipient will be shown how to undertake basic checks to maintain the vehicle in working condition. On top of that, our partners at West Somerset Advice and Rusty Road 2 Recovery will support recipients with financial advice and a free vehicle check within the first 6 months of ownership."

Raj Singh, CCS Deputy Chief Executive, says:

"Your generosity will make a huge difference to those unable to access work or education because they have no affordable means of getting there. We urge you to consider donating your unwanted car to offer a life-changing opportunity to someone in your local community."

TONY TAKLE (1935 – 2020)

Tony Takle was well-known and much-loved throughout Exmoor. Originally from Wheddon Cross (where he went to work at Thorne Farm as soon as he could leave school), he later settled at Kendle Farm, Exton, where he raised his family and stayed until retirement. He once told me that he had two ambitions as a young man - to own his own farm, and to marry the prettiest girl on Exmoor, and told me proudly: I managed both by the time I was 24!' (He married Hilda Stevens in 1957, two years before moving to Kendle.) Tony loved farming, and loved showing his livestock at local shows, but he was a man of energy and drive, and enjoyed many interests outside the farm. He was a born entertainer, with a fine voice and a love of singing, as well as a great talent for storytelling. The years he spent with The Village Minstrels brought pleasure to him as much as to the audiences they entertained, and many on Exmoor will remember him in this way. Cutcombe Young Farmers Club benefited from Tony's gifts. as he brought his talents to bear in directing productions for the drama competition, taking a production all the way to the national finals in the early nineteen-eighties.

He had a well-developed sense of humour, and

perhaps also a keen sense of mischief: asked once by a visitor to Bridgetown if he was 'local' he replied 'no, I used to live at Wheddon Cross'. Tony's Christian faith went deep, and his record of service to the church on Exmoor is hard to equal: he served St Peter's, Exton, as Churchwarden for 51 years, and as Tower Captain for nearly as many, as well a singing in the Benefice Choir.

It is hard to avoid clichés when talking of such a simple, straightforward, and utterly extraordinary man, but clichés would hardly do him justice. When Peter and I moved to Exmoor he was warm and sincere in his welcome, and I can only say that I feel privileged to have known Tony Takle. My prayers are for his family at this time, and will be for time to come.

He lies next to his beloved Hilda (who died in the spring) in the spot that he chose, at the foot of the bank between the 'old' and 'new' graveyards, where there was once a hedge which he dug out by hand to create the 'new' graveyard. It is a good spot, with a wonderful view of Exmoor hills and fields, and a fitting resting-place for a true Exmoor farmer and a storyteller of whom stories will now be told.




