

Upcoming events are listed on page 56 and 57 - something to look foward to! As ever, a huge thank you to all those contribute, advertise and help deliver our magazine.





NEWS FROM YOUR VILLAGE AGENT – SPRING 2021

Spring is in full swing and so is the COVID-19 vaccine roll out! By mid-April all those in the 9 priority groups will have been invited to have their vaccinations, and many will have had their second dose.

If you are an unpaid Carer, you are eligible to be vaccinated with the person you care for as long as you meet the eligibility criteria. Please do remember to register with your Doctor's surgery letting them know you are an unpaid Carer if you haven't already done so.

Many people will however still be shielding and remaining isolated until restrictions are further eased in the summer. If this is you, have you thought about joining a Befriending Service? There are several options whereby you can talk regularly with someone on the phone – or sometimes even via the internet – and this simple act of communication can be invaluable in relieving loneliness and isolation.

We are delighted to let you know that CCS has launched a NEW project called CHAT TO CONNECT for those classed as Clinically Extremely Vulnerable (CEV). We know it's good to talk and share experiences. Chat to Connect is aimed at helping to link you with new people in a similar position, with shared interests. Through the Chat to Connect project we can connect you with another person who is on the CEV list to keep your spirits up. You will need to complete the short online registration form, and we will match you with another person with

similar interests and hobbies.

If you feel you would benefit from some technical support in order to connect with someone, CCS can also offer one-to-one virtual support with using phones, tablets, and laptops, downloading apps, and using Zoom or WhatsApp.

We have people ready to help you get online and talk to others! Go to: https://ccslovesomerset.org/chat-to-connect/ or contact your Village Agent for assistance.

There are several other telephone befriending services available in Somerset and nationally - your Village Agent can provide information on these.

Other ways to connect to people

If you are on Facebook, local community pages or Covid support groups can keep you in touch with what is going on locally. To find a group or community page close to you use the Facebook search bar, typing in the area you live, and then select, to view groups. This should give you a list of groups where local people share information, ask advice and start conversations with each other – it can be a great way to get to know people in your area!

Since the start of the pandemic many organisations have starting to offer more support via the internet and your Village Agent can provide you with information on a range of these including book clubs, art and creative clubs, support for keeping active, business networking and on-line courses where you can sign up to learn a new skill.

The Community Council for Somerset Crisis Fund

Our Crisis Fund grants are distributed by our Village and Community Agents to help people in crisis situations and for whom a small grant can make a huge difference in their life. At this particular time of difficulty and hardship for many in our communities, this need is greater than ever. We help when others can't, won't, or don't.

CCS have not previously needed to actively fundraise for the Crisis Fund, but this has been an unprecedented year, and this critical 'pot' of funds has almost depleted due to unprecedented demand arising from the Covid-19 pandemic. 

Some people have no idea of what the county flag looks like. Basically the Somerset flag is a red dragon rampant on a yellow background.

The dragon is the ancient flag of the Kingdom of Wessex, the white Saxon version of which is seen on the Bayeaux Tapestry falling with King Harold at the battle of Hastings (1066).

On a local basis the Red Dragon is the symbol of the Somerset County Council which shows a red dragon holding a blue mace (the symbol of authority) on a white background). There is a Taunton based organisation that promotes our county day as well as our county flag https://www.somersetday.com but whether it is a Somerset flag or Somerset bunting, you can contact your local flag maker – Red Dragon Flagmakers at Dulverton 01398 323700 who hold a large stock of flags of many sizes and windsocks etc

The Lichenologist's Tale

It was a chance encounter that sparked Lucy Gould's interest in those extraordinary, primeval-looking organisms known as lichens. While walking near the home she shares with her partner, Justin, in Oakford, she met a group of lichenologists. They mentioned a particularly interesting and rare species of lichen that could be seen nearby; Lucy's curiosity was piqued...

As a regional manager for an international lifestyle retailer, Lucy would normally be working flat out but with the arrival of Covid-19, lockdown, and her job furloughed, everything changed.

'I found myself in limbo,' says Lucy, 'not knowing when or if I would go back to work. But I was lucky to be furloughed in such a beautiful place, with time to slow down and appreciate what we have.'

Originally from Surrey, Lucy has always loved being outdoors and, during lockdown, was able to spend more time than usual walking in local woodlands and along riverbanks.

'I noticed a lot of fallen branches, covered in great clusters of lichens,' she says, 'Many of the branches were ash, clearly impacted by ash dieback.'

Lucy is fascinated by the history of lichens and the role they play in the health of the planet. 'They are created by a fungus and an algae (or bacteria) that combine to support each other, providing life and oxygen,' she explains.

Lichens first appeared on Earth about 400 million years ago and some species have been around for at least 25 million years. Rhizocarpus geographicum, found in the Arctic, is approximately 8,600 years old - one of our oldest living organisms. The UK is home to 1,900 species; Devon has 900, and there are many lichen species in Exmoor's ancient woodlands.

'Most lichens are highly susceptible to air pollution so, if you have them, you know you have very clean air!' says Lucy. 'The West Country is also one of the last remaining UK locations for Lobaria pulmonaria but its decline continues due to loss of habitat.' This rare

lichen can still be found in Exmoor's Horner Woods Natural Nature Reserve, as can Arthonia thoriana, a new species discovered there in 2016. To date, it has been found nowhere else in the world.

Lucy wants more of us to get involved in protecting lichens and the environments in which they thrive, particularly trees and woodlands. She is a member of the Devon Wildlife Trust, whose Saving Devon Treescapes project provides information, runs school projects, and even donates free trees.

'As many of us found during lockdown, we need these environments not only for the good of the planet but for our own physical and mental well-being too,' she says. 'Looking at lichens is very simple and relatively cheap. You just need some outdoor gear, a field lens for close inspection, and a phone with a camera to log your finds. I'm back at work now but I'll still be walking far and wide, looking for lichens at every opportunity.'





Ashley Combe Landscape Restoration in Culbone Wood

This walk will follow the South West Coast Path from Ashley Combe to Culbone Church and back, looking at the work to restore some of the surviving features of the Ada Lovelace era designed landscape. A Country Property Diary

It's been many a year since I last ran a "Country Property Diary" when it was at that time a bi

weekly feature within the West Somerset Free Press. At the time it received some wonderful feedback (and also the odd criticism which is fair enough and encourages open and healthy debate), so I welcome you all to this my first and now regular bi monthly update on all things property in the area.

Lots of things have changed in property since my last feature (probably about 15 or more years ago) and indeed, looking ahead, how the property market, our daily lives, transport and jobs will change in the next 15 plus years are going to be both incredible and daunting at the same time. I hope to touch on many of these things in the months ahead but for now this first review is an update on what is happening in the local market just to get us started.

As we all know, last year was a very busy year in property across the whole of the UK and to those of us in the industry it did and indeed still does, feel somewhat surreal that certain professions were allowed to keep working, others not and the undoubted impact that has unfortunately had. One could have been forgiven for thinking that the property market should have crashed last year (many expected it, many still predict it) but in truth the very latest national predictions are that the property market across the whole of the UK will continue to be busy with between 1 and 1.25 million transactions each year for the next 4/5 years (taken from industry data and reports as well as predictions from nationally recognised "Behavioural Economists" who at Webbers and Fine & Country we work with closely to help us gauge and advise our clients on the market ahead).

Locally, that national trend looks to be as relevant for us on Exmoor and the close surrounding area. The interesting balance last year for us locally was the number of people who were buying local homes that were already local, had lived locally (moved away for jobs or relationships) but now moving home, those

who lived within 30 miles to those that have never lived locally but have family living locally so wanted to move to be close. That collectively

equated to about 69% of all of our local property sales right across the whole spectrum of the property market (from properties under £200,000 to multi million pound homes). With only 30/31% of sales going to people that had no such connection with the area other than perhaps having visited at some stage for holidays etc.

At the moment that trend of sales to people with a local connection seems to be continuing but it is difficult to say how long for and by how much that may revert back to the more typical historical balance of 50/70% of away buyers. It is however great to see for now.

As we enter the spring and summer months and with slowly lockdown measures being eased as appropriate, I'm sure all of us will start to feel more positive about the year ahead. Certainly a nice sunny day, with Exmoor as your backdrop, then it's pretty hard to beat in anyone's book and as a result our local property market always gets a spring in its step as a direct result with both new buyers and indeed local home owners making the most of the better time of year.

Whilst moving forward I have a number of property related topics to work on, I am happy to have feedback from anyone if there are property related topics that you feel you would like covered and that I feel capable of answering for you. 

When I left the 'rat race' 17 years ago to teach dressage full-time, I never envisaged training as an eauine bodyworker or saddle-fitter. But I found that lessons so often turned into 'troubleshooting'. I qualified in Pilates to help riders with their stability and symmetry, but still I was frequently asking 'are you sure your horse is ok?' or 'are you really comfortable in that saddle?' No amount of teaching skill can make it comfortable for a horse that's contracted down the right-hand side of his body to bend left - and kicking harder is not the answer! Nor can a rider do a comfortable rising trot if their saddle is placing their legs too far in front of them. It's easy to think that the answer to everything is to get shouted out and to 'ride the horse through it, but that is just a cop-out.

Horses like a quiet life and are generally eager to please, to fit in and to comply with our demands. Body language is the horse's means of communication, and unwanted behaviour or poor performance usually stem from a lack of understanding or physical pain (and there is good scientific evidence to back this up).

For bodywork I use the wonderful Masterson Method®, in which the horse is very much part of the process, plus acupressure, myofascial release and laser therapy. Bodyworkers are not vets and do not diagnose problems, but regular maintenance can help to prevent, or flag up early, problems which might become veterinary issues down the line. It is wonderful to help horses release the tightness and restrictions which prevent their performing happily and comfortably, and I feel very privileged to do this as a job! I am now partway through an Animal Physiotherapy Diploma -and I'm looking forward to getting more involved in post-injury rehabilitation (yes I'm a course junkie!)






