

# A Country Property Diary

# How property programmes have changed who now buys properties for restoration

When I first started back in 1984, we used to work on the basis that, on average, once a month, a derelict property or home requiring major restoration would come up for sale. In those days, programmes such as To Buy or Not to Buy (BBC1), Location, Location, Location (Channel 4), Escape to the Country (BBC 1 and 2) and Homes under the Hammer (UK TV Style) amongst many others just didn't exist and, as a result, many properties requiring modernisation or restoration were more often than not sold to a developer who had the skills and experience to modernise and then resell the property. The major differencemeant, that a developer needed to make a profit and as a result, had to offer accordingly when purchasing the property in the first place.

36/37 years later so much has changed and, in truth for the better for the owner selling any property that requires such extensive work. 20 plus years of property restoration programmes have created their own dynamic within the property world, to the extent that when a single property comes up for sale requiring either general modernisation or even full blown historical restoration a developer almost never has the chance to buy the property, with private buyers seriously out bidding any developer by many tens of thousands of pounds as a bare minimum.

**So why is this?** Buyers these days feel far more comfortable about taking on a project to do up, in part facilitated by the past few decades of TV programmes giving them confidence that modernising properties is no longer the sole prevail of builders and developers.

So what does this mean to you the seller? In a nutshell it means that the price that you achieve for your property is no longer at a reduced rate to accommodate for the developer needing to (not unreasonably) make a profit for their efforts. Buyers now are not only paying full price but also, in many many cases, paying an enhanced premium to secure the property that they want to live in and then spend the next 2/5/10 years restoring and as a result pay prices that

would historically have been completely unachievable.

Three recent examples marketed by our Dulverton office include Bungsland Farm, a derelict Grade II\* Listed home set in 58 acres. 13 genuine buyers viewed, multiple private buyers bid by Informal Tender, eventual agreed price substantially in excess of the Guide Price. Hawtree House - 19 genuine buyers viewed, multiple sealed bids received and at the time of writing this article offers substantially in excess of the asking price received. Finally "Bullseye", a well known landmark also offered for sale by Informal Tender with 12 genuine buyers viewing and a sale agreed in excess of the Guide price.





#### The Wine Merchant's Tale

You might be forgiven for thinking that opening a shop during a pandemic, and just before the country's second Covid-19 lockdown, was something of a gamble. But, according to Nick Payne, the owner of Corks and Cru, it was a risk worth taking. His Bampton shop, which sells fine wines, craft beers, ciders, spirits, a non-alcoholic range, and gifts, has now been open for just over a year and has exceeded all expectations.

Deep local roots – Nick grew up near Morebath – have helped, as has his knowledge of retailing; his family owned Bampton's popular bakery, Bawden's, for almost 75 years from 1939. Nick worked in the bakery when he was at school and in 2011, aged just 21, took over the business. 'Running a bakery is a very demanding, 23-hour a day operation,' explains Nick. 'The shop lease was due to expire in 2018 and I was beginning to think about changing direction.' So he took a couple of years out, working in other jobs, while planning a different future.

Nick had always been interested in wine and he and his wife, Vikki, enjoyed going to vineyards and wine shops while on holiday. A visit to a Cornish wine merchant proved particularly inspiring. Bampton, thought Nick, would be the ideal location for something similar. 'People drive for miles to shop here,' he said. 'Our independent retailers - butcher, baker, greengrocer - are a real draw. I'd always loved running a shop, so why not become a wine merchant?' It was a smart move: in the past decade, Bampton has also become something of a foodie destination for local people and visitors, with excellent restaurants, whose customers appreciate good wine (unlike the guests at Fawlty Towers, according to Basil...)

'Fine wine has a story, a history; there's a family behind it and a passion,' says Nick, who developed his existing knowledge by attending courses run by wine expert and consultant sommelier, Rebecca Mitchell. 'There is always something new to learn,' he says. It is one of the things he loves most about the world of wine.

Despite the success of Corks and Cru, including online sales, the past year has not been without its challenges: Covid-19, changes in border regulations, a shortage of HGV drivers, and interruptions to fuel supplies. Deliveries from Europe that once took four weeks now take 12; forward planning means constant adjustments to ensure well-stocked shelves.

Customer service is a priority: welcoming people, getting to know individual preferences, and helping with recommendations. So we asked Nick what wines he would serve with a traditional Christmas Day dinner? 'Start with a sparkling Burgundy Crémant, it goes with everything,' he suggests. 'Then, depending on your main course, either a Californian Chardonnay if you want white or, if red, a young Burgundy or an aged Rioja or Barolo. And to accompany a rich pudding, a Spanish Moscatel or a 6 Puttonyos Tokaji.'

As Robert Louis Stevenson once remarked, 'Wine is bottled poetry.'

DWLCT volunteers recently joined North Devon Archaeological Society in a 4 day archaeological dig on Dulverton Weir, uncovering a large number of artefacts which will need further study.



Two trenches were dug to learn more about the weir structure buried under the island adjacent to the sluice gates in Northmoor Road (at the southernmost end of the

visible weir structure).

Trench one confirmed the position of the built structure complete with a 'toe' stone at the base of the weir.



Identical 'toe' stones are clearly visible in a section of the weir in the open air which can be viewed from Northmoor Road if standing next to the sluice gates.



Trench two revealed nothing of the weir structure, although a lot of other items (mainly fragments of Victorian pottery and glass were found) this is something of a mystery and further investigation will be necessary.



North Devon Archaeological Society will, in due course, be publishing a full report and later this year the Trust plans to hold an 'Open Day' event in Dulverton Library to share the report and show artefacts found.

#### Exmoor Young Voices Update Summer '21.

Self Build Project. EYV has started a pilot project for 6 young couples to self build quality homes. Property prices and rents have soared even further beyond young people's reach during C19. Financial help is vital to sustain essential, young, Exmoor knowledge, skills and experience. EYV can access self build land, loans and



grants, training, an experienced Exmoor self builder as project leader, a pro bono lawyer to advise on loan arrangements, and planning support from the National Park. A team approach ensures economies of scale for the self builders, especially in sharing skills and purchasing materials. <a href="https://www.exmooryoungvoices.org/eyv-self-build.html">https://www.exmooryoungvoices.org/eyv-self-build.html</a>

**Finance.** EYV has established a partnership with Lendology who are able to source grants and loans from local authorities for local needs housing. EYV also has a private Foundation grant of £20,000, starting a small loan fund for deposits on land, purchase of materials, architects' drawings, planning negotiations etc. The target for this fund is £100,000. The self build project commences September 2021.

Exmoor Summit. Young people's housing needs are urgent. Councils and Housing Associations must make young people a priority if they want them to stay and work. This is the most aged district in England already. EYV invited all 9 of Exmoor's County, District, Park, and Housing Authorities, before C19 struck, to explore what pledges they could make to secure a future for young workers on Exmoor. The postponed recall of that event, a groundbreaking partnership including local charities and young EYV Members, will take place this autumn if C19 subsides sufficiently for an effective Summit to take place.

**Problems**. EYV has helped 15 young families recently to overcome (apparently) insurmountable blocks and barriers to their housing needs. The system for housing young people on Exmoor needs urgent attention. Two local families, who all agencies agree have vital housing need right now, are still blocked a year later. The costs in time, money and advisors is disproportionate.

Homefinder, the Local Authority/National Park registration process, and website, have both been improved, with EYV members' advice. It is much better but still difficult for many. EYV supports applicants to register, while also monitoring less visible housing needs.

**Effective Broadband.** EYV Members have been championing vital improvements. This is a slow, cumbersome process, inhibiting business and public life in the National Park.

CPRE. EYV Chair advises on rural, and especially National Park, needs.

**Support.** EYV Members have also addressed Parliament, BBC, Countryfile, radio, ITV, all of Exmoor's 56 public Authorities, and secured the professional services of nine professional advisors in housing, planning, self building, IT, travel, training, enterprise, employment, charity law, and funding. 

#### **Protecting Hedgehogs**

Lisa Chapman- Hedgehog & Bird Rescue on Exmoor.

Hedgehogs are mostly insect eaters and their natural diet consists of beetles, caterpillars and earthworms, hence being known as the Gardener's Friend. Most people will often put out a bowl of food for them, either wet pet food or kitten biscuits to supplement their own natural diet which they will always accept and enjoy. Always remember though that the traditional bowl of milk that we used to put out when we were children is now a definite No No as they are intolerant to lactose and of course I must point out that Mealworms do a great deal of damage to their bones, so always be careful and check if you are not sure on what is good or bad for them. Ensure there is always a good supply of water for them to drink, no matter what the weather.

You can make your garden Hedgehog friendly by ensuring they can access all areas, a hedgehog highway between gardens is an excellent start. They like to hibernate and shelter in dry areas, such as leaf piles, or under sheds and in hedgerows. If you are cutting grass, strimming or generally tidying up areas of your garden, please make sure you check before you start as they can be easy to miss, especially take care if you intend to burn any garden material as they may be in the pile you are about to light. Slug Pellets are poisonous and should not be used. If absolutely necessary, pellets should be placed in a pipe or under a slate that hedgehogs cannot get to. Dead slugs removed daily. It will be illegal to use metaldehyde slug pellets in the UK from April 2022 and it is already illegal to sell them. Be aware of any water such as ponds or pools as if they fall in they may not be able to get back out without a little ramp or slope. Keep an eye on rubbish that may be accumulating as they can easily get caught up in nets, bags and more often plastic rings from can/tin packs. You can easily make a Hedgehog house for hibernation, there are plenty of ideas online, even an upside down plastic container with a small cut out door, some hay and food will attract them to set up

camp. Hibernation usually occurs between November and mid-March. Hedgehogs can give birth to their young later in the year, this leaves the little ones with not a lot of time to build up to their optimum weight before they hibernate. A good weight for hibernation is around 450-600gms or more. If you ever come across a lone Hedgehog, or one that is



small or underwieght or is out during the day, then we need to make sure that they are brought to a rescue as soon as possible as they are more than likely unwell or need some extra assistance. I can do this by ensuring their weights are checked, they have the correct medication if needed and giving them the right diet and any other help that they need. I will then release back to the wild when I am absolutely certain they are ready.

I am absolutely passionate and determined in my role to rescue, rehabilitate and release as many Hedgehogs that are brought to me, back to where they came from. We are close to loosing these beautiful, placid, wonderful creatures and I feel everyone seems to be more aware of not only the issues these little guys face everyday, be it environmental or otherwise, but are wanting to be able to help and look after them. We have a great opportunity, through making little changes here and there, keeping an eye on them when they are in our gardens and generally being more aware of their presence, to ensure that they not only survive, but begin to thrive again in our beautiful natural world.



OCEAN EXPLORERS SUMMER SUCCESS FOR LOCAL FNVIRONMENTAL CHARITY

PLASTIC FREE NORTH DEVON TAKE OVER **2500** PEOPLE ON A VIRTUAL DIVING EXPERIENCE WITH SEALS AT LUNDY ISLAND THIS SUMMER THROUGH THEIR OCEAN EXPLORER PROJECT

Local charity Plastic Free North Devon (PFND) aims to connect people with their natural surroundings through conversations, education and events, to inspire locals and visitors alike to protect what our very existence depends on. The charity's Ocean Explorer educational outreach project sits right at the heart of their mission to increase care and stewardship over the natural world by using education alongside real-life experiences, an approach summed up by Sir David Attenborough: "Noone will protect what they don't care about; and no one will care about what they have never experienced".

Setting the foundations in July, the charity took 16 carefully selected Year 9 students from across North Devon to Lundy Island to experience first hand the nature on our doorstep. Half of them went on a snorkeling safari, and the other half went on a sea safari around the island. The assistant Lundy ranger joined both groups of children, providing an insight into the work that goes on and her route into the conservation sector. As part of the programme, all students were then asked to be part of the charity's Ocean Explorer summer outreach and present back to their school about their experience, giving them a deeper understanding of the work of the charity and empowering them to act within their own lives.

After these successful trips, the Ocean Explorer Ambassadors and volunteers took the message out into the community using virtual reality diving experiences, storytelling, rockpool ID, citizen science research, story time, face painting, Ocean Explorer caricatures, beach and park cleans, dry aquarium, seaside yoga, and arts and crafts. A range of locations across North Devon and Torridge welcomed the Ocean Explorer interactive experience over the summer, including: Birdman Festival Ilfracombe, On The Road music festival, Clovelly Maritime Festival, Lynmouth Visitor Centre, Torrington Commons, Milky Way, and various local parks and beaches, with over £800 raised through donations and raffle tickets, enabling the charity to continue their vital work in the local community.

Chloe Lovelass, Ocean Explorer Ambassador, explained the importance of the project:

"There are so many threats to our marine environment, from the clearly visible plastic pollution to the growing climate emergency. We have really enjoyed inspiring people to look after the fragile ecosystems that support us all and show people just how amazing the nature on our doorstep is, how it supports us and how we can all do things to look after it."

The virtual reality underwater adventures, featuring a dive off the coast of Lundy and encountering the local grey seal population, were experienced by around 2500 visitors and locals, eliciting numerous 'wows' and 'gasps'. Visitors were then signposted to many of the different ways that they can get involved with protecting our environment; from careers, to volunteering, relevant petitions and campaigns, extra learning, and local organisations doing amazing things.

Anne-Marie Eveleigh, Operations Manager summed up the last six weeks:

"We are really pleased with how the Ocean Explorers project has played out this summer. After over a year of hiccups due to Covid 19 it was fantastic to be back out talking and inspiring people to protect what we all love. We were able to recruit a new cohort of Ocean Explorer volunteers who were invaluable in assisting the ambassadors and we will be building on how well the summer went by heading to community groups across North Devon to reach everyone with our messaging."

Volunteering formed a significant and valuable part of the summer's activities, empowering students and other Ocean Explorer volunteers to help run the project, learning new skills and advocating for the environment. 65% of the Year 9 students volunteered with the project contributing nearly 100 hours and 12 Ocean Explorer Volunteers contributed over 150 hours to the project.

Plastic Free North Devon and their Ocean Explorers are now looking to connect with local community groups, youth clubs, scouts, guides and brownies etc to continue to deliver their outreach into the Autumn and beyond through structured workshops, drop-in sessions, and talks. ## **Exmoor Pony Centre, Ashwick, Dulverton TA22 9QE**

After a busy end to our visitor season at the Exmoor Pony Centre, we are refocusing our workload to foals and fundraising! Throughout the Autumn, mostly in October, the moorland herds of Exmoor ponies have been gathered in and the ponies checked over. The herd owners then decide which foals they may keep for future breeding and which foals need to find new homes. In an ideal world all the foals would find new homes with buyers who are looking forward to the fun and rewarding experience of handling and training a young Exmoor pony. Sadly, not all of the annual foal crop find a buyer and that is where the work of the Moorland Mousie Trust and Exmoor Pony Centre comes in. Our charity takes these unsold foals who are mostly colts (boys) and we handle and neuter them, preparing them for future lives away from the moor. You may wonder why these unsold ponies cannot merely return to their herd, well as many of the unsold ponies are boys they cannot return to the herd as that may allow inbreeding between the young boys and their female relatives.

Foal Handling time at the Exmoor Pony Centre is an amazing experience and we encourage people to get in touch and book an appointment to visit us and of course to join in on our Foal Handling Course during November/ December. It's always a day to remember so call quick to see if there are any spaces still available.

The Autumn months are always a good time to catch up with our MMT ponies all over the country to undertake a formal health check before Winter and to ensure all is well around the various foster and grazing sites. Linzi headed up to the North-East of England back in September to see some of our grazing herds and what a fabulous place it is for our ponies to live. Linzi was pleased to report that all the ponies were happy and healthy, with our Exmoor based ponies in comparison definitely looking a little more winter ready than their northern counterparts!

Luckily becoming winter ready is an important part of our ridden ponies' yearly routine, with many of our hard working visitor centre team heading off to kick up their heels and have a well-earned break. Don't worry if Almond is your favourite or maybe Winston is, they will be back in the Spring to say hello to everyone once we re-open.

Don't forget you can support us by buying gifts from our shop. Throughout the Winter we will be onsite at the centre so give us a call and either arrange a time to collect your shopping or we can post it to you. We also have an online shop on our website so have a look at our lovely Exmoor pony themed items. We have 2022 Calendars and all your last-minute Christmas cards and gifts.
